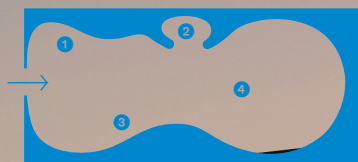

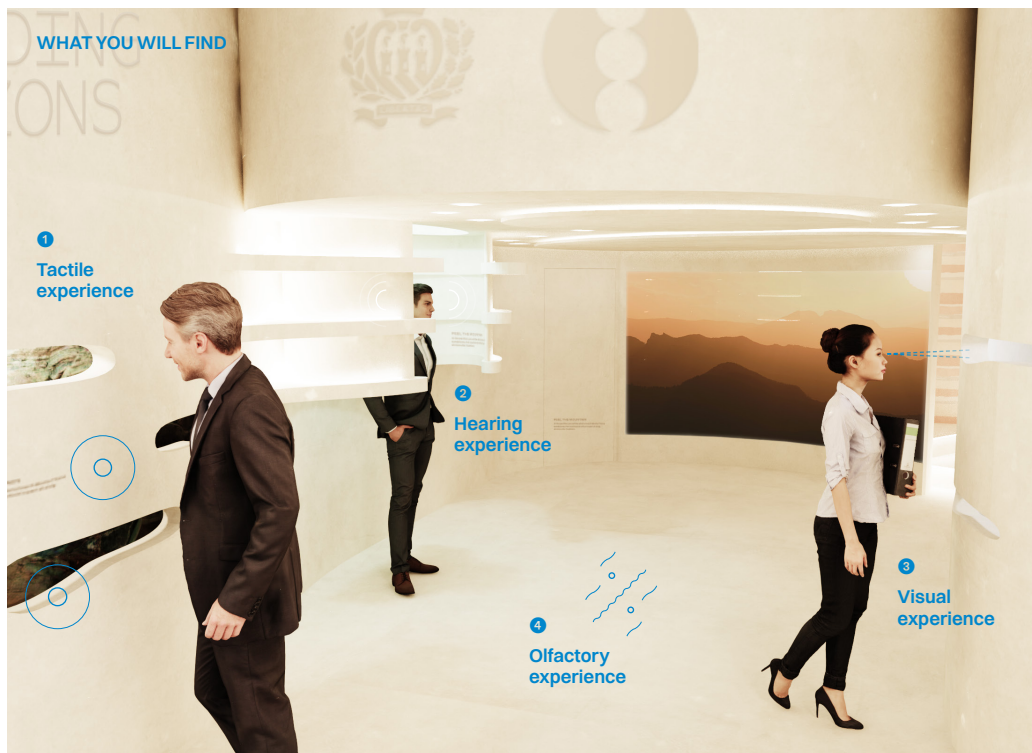

PAVILION PLAN



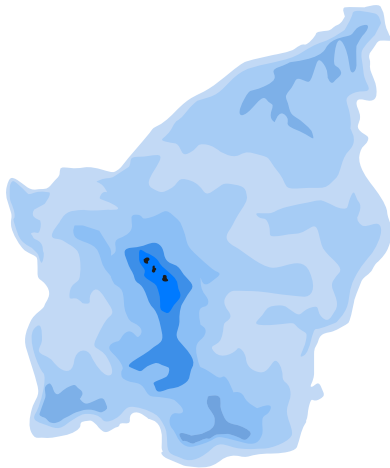
WHAT YOU WILL FIND



THE CONCEPT

The ascent of a mountain broadens the boundaries of our sight and becomes a symbol of the expansion of horizons. From above, you can understand much more, and the view opens up to the Republic of San Marino and the surrounding territories.

The Pavilion is inspired by the unique **morphology of the Republic of San Marino**, characterized by a series of hills and peaks extending across the central part of the small state. It includes **Monte Titano**, the main mountain formation in the region, offering spectacular views of the surrounding area. Monte Titano consists of three main peaks: Monte Titano, Monte della Fratta, and Monte Cerreto. The visit offers an **immersive experience** in which every element of the Pavilion is connected, reflecting the unity and cohesion of the Republic of San Marino.



THE EXHIBITION ROUTE

Visitors will experience the essence and beauty of San Marino's landscape through three distinct sensory experiences.



FEEL THE MOUNTAIN

In the pavilion you will be able to touch Monte Titano sandstone, the local stone which is part of a big stonemason tradition.



LISTEN TO EVERYDAY LIFE

As you come inside, you will hear the sounds and scents of a lively community that builds memories upon its territory.



ADMIRE THE VIEWS

Take a peak at the peculiar spots around the historic town center or the lesser known strolls - we'll accompany you as the time passes by during the day.

At the end of your visit, you can discover and buy our local and artisanal productions at the shop in front of the Pavilion entrance.

A HISTORY LESSON

The oldest manuscript on the life of San Marino, nominated for UNESCO Memory of the World Register is at Expo 2025 Osaka.

The volume *Vita Sancti Marini* is the oldest manuscript discovered about **the life of San Marino**. It recounts the physical and spiritual journey that led Marino, a stonemason, in the late 3rd to early 4th century AD, from the Dalmatian coast island of Arbe—now Rab in Croatia—to the shores of the Upper Adriatic on the Italian peninsula, near the Roman city of Ariminum (Rimini), eventually **settling on Monte Titano**, today known as San Marino. The work, a limited edition publication, whose original copy is preserved at the National University Library of Turin, will be displayed within the Pavilion of San Marino.

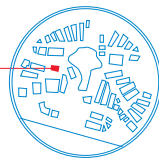


Come discover our country
